

## 2021 Panhellenic Executive Officer Application

### **What is Panhellenic Council?**

Panhellenic Council governs the ENTIRE Panhellenic Sorority Community. They work together to organize and structure Panhellenic wide events including Recruitment. This is a major leadership position within the Community as chapters' report to Panhellenic. Panhellenic works to unite sorority women together to focus on common goals and to create a network of support for chapters and members. We provide interactive programs and activities for sorority women and all Indiana University Southeast students.

### **Would training be provided?**

Panhellenic Council Transitions and Training will take place depending on . Incoming officers are also asked to spend 1-2 hours with the outgoing officer to discuss their responsibilities and commitment.

### **Would I need to be a Gamma Chi?**

It depends on your sorority affiliation and their by-laws.

### **What does being a Gamma Chi mean?**

A Gamma Chi (GX) is a recruitment counselor. She is an active sorority member who disaffiliates temporarily from her sorority to guide and support women through Recruitment process. GX will help Potential New Members (PNMs) understand the specifics of the Recruitment process and act as mentors while the PNM's make important decisions. By not representing a sorority, GXs are able to give PNM's unbiased and honest support. PNM's feel more comfortable talking to women about their concerns when they are not concerned about impressing or offending the women. Disaffiliation enables GXs to answer questions and guide PNM's without bias or preference to a particular chapter.

### **Who is eligible to be on Panhellenic Council?**

Any woman who has been in chapter for at least one calendar year, has held at least one leadership position within the chapter or shows significant leadership elsewhere and holds a 2.5 GPA is eligible. This woman must also remain an active member in her chapter throughout her tenure.

### **What would the commitment entail?**

Council members can expect to spend **at least** one hour a week in meetings. President needs to meet with the Greek Life Advisor at least every other week to update and discuss community details. Council members will be required to attend all trainings and meetings held throughout the year and are highly encouraged to attend all programming events. Recruitment in the fall is also a requirement.
